About us

Because no sick child should be without their family by their side.

Since 1981, Ronald McDonald House Charities (RMHC) Toronto has served as a place to call home for families with seriously ill children undergoing treatment. We are an independent charity, governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and operated by staff and volunteers. The first and largest chapter in Canada, RMHC Toronto is part of a network of more than 380 licensed Ronald McDonald House Programs and 285 Ronald McDonald Family Room Programs across the globe.

We encompass:

- An 81-family House in downtown Toronto
- 7 Family Rooms in 5 hospitals:
 - Centenary site of Scarborough Health Network, Scarborough (2)
 - Health Sciences North, Sudbury
 - Oak Valley Health's Markham Stouffville Hospital, Markham
 - The Hospital for Sick Children (SickKids), Toronto
 - Trillium Health Partners' Credit Valley Hospital, Mississauga (2)

Few can imagine the experience of having a child who is fighting for their life. Now imagine you are among the 65% of Canadians who live outside a city with a children's hospital. The stress and expense of this experience is overwhelming for families.

This is why RMHC Toronto exists – to give families a place to call home close to their child in the hospital.

Thank you for your support, which keeps families close at the most difficult time in their lives.

With your support, RMHC Toronto increased its impact as we emerged from the pandemic in 2022. We accommodated more families at our House, and our in-hospital Family Rooms have continued to re-open, with all five sites available again to families. We increased both our in-person and virtual activity programming, our school enrolment grew, and we hired a new Food Services Manager to prepare home-cooked meals for our families.

While our impact grew in 2022, we also began planning for future growth. We are acutely aware we must increase our capacity to serve more families. There are tremendous unmet needs.

The first step in this expansion is the opening of a second Family Room at SickKids in spring 2024, quadrupling our Family Room capacity at the hospital from 50 to 200 family members at a time.

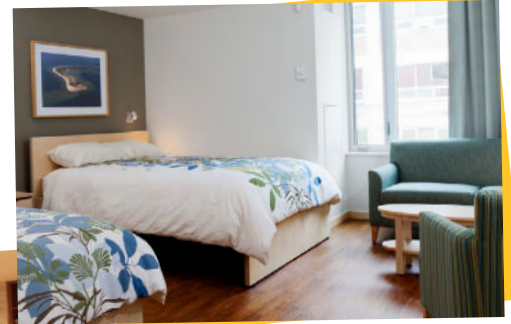

Our Family Rooms

Ronald McDonald Family Rooms provide a place like home within the hospital so parents can rest and retreat just steps from where their children are being treated. Family Rooms are a place to put up your feet, sleep, watch TV, have a coffee, a meal or a shower. It's also a place for a listening ear. We were delighted for all 5 hospital sites to be open in 2022 as pandemic restrictions lifted.

RMHC Toronto School continued to offer flexible, hybrid learning through both virtual and on-site classes.

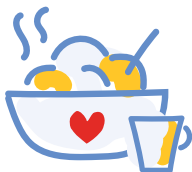
