What You'll Do:

- Welcome and engage children and their siblings while they stay with us, creating a positive and engaging learning environment.
- Greet students as they arrive, ensuring they feel comfortable and excited for their school day.
- Assist teachers in meeting the diverse learning and emotional needs of students from JK to Grade 8.
- Provide one-on-one or small-group support to help students complete their schoolwork.
- Monitor and organize school supplies, notifying staff when items need replenishment.
- Maintain a clean, safe, and organized classroom environment.

Skills & Qualifications:

- At least one year of experience working with children and/or youth in a school setting.
- Passion for working with children and adaptability to different daily experiences.
- Ability to support children and adults who may be under stress or in crisis situations.
- Comfortable working around students with special needs or those who may be visibly ill.
- Strong ability to follow directions, policies, and procedures effectively.
- Excellent communication skills, with a compassionate and patient approach.
- Highly reliable and punctual, with a strong sense of responsibility.
- Ability to maintain appropriate boundaries and confidentiality at all times.

Commitment: We are looking for volunteers who can commit to a **regular weekly 3-hour** shift **on the same day and time** for a **minimum of six months** starting from April 2025.

- **Orientation and Training:** To attend an orientation and complete all necessary training modules before starting their shift.
